**PETROQUEST RESOURCES, INC. ANNOUNCES
COMPLETION OF 4.5 MILE NATURAL GAS PIPELINE**

Arlington, Texas — February 21, 2006 — PetroQuest Resources, Inc. (Computer Pink Sheets: PQRJ.PK), announced today that Majestic Oil Field Services, Inc. (“Majestic”), the Company’s wholly owned operations subsidiary, recently completed laying approximately 4.5 miles of low pressure pipeline in West Virginia to transport natural gas for a customer that owns 14 gas wells which Majestic operates. The pipeline is owned by Twin Fork Transportation, L.L.C., a Nevada limited liability company. PetroQuest Resources, Inc. owns 51% of Twin Fork Transportation, L.L.C.

This 4.5 mile pipeline is the first step in a planned interconnection of gas and oil wells owned and operated by PetroQuest Resources, Inc.’s subsidiaries. The next step in the interconnection process will be the construction and laying by Majestic of a pipeline approximately 6 miles long that will connect 20 producing gas and oil wells owned by Mountaineer Gas Transmission, Inc., PetroQuest’s wholly owned production subsidiary, and the 14 gas wells discussed above to a 14.5 mile natural gas gathering system owned by Twin Fork Transportation, L.L.C.

PetroQuest Resources, Inc.’s President, Warren F. Lory, stated:

Transferring gas sales from the current sales outlet point (a closed system primarily for residential distribution) to the new sales point in Twin Fork’s 14.5 mile gas gathering system (an open system supplying commercial users) will increase net revenues to the Company because the gas sold at the new sales point will not have to be dried prior to being sold, a process which strips a significant percentage of the BTU’s out of the natural gas before it is sold. Higher BTU rating natural gas sells for a higher price than stripped (dried) natural gas.
